Race Information

Ski marking – no ski exchanges.

Clothing drop at start – will be moved to finish.

Athletes must keep track of number of laps skied.

50 km course (and 20 km): Two tracks will be set all the way around each course- where possible, there will be three tracks set; 3 feed zones have been set up – coaches can feed anywhere on the course, but these areas have been identified as the safest zones for feeding. The factory feed zone (FF) will have water and Gatorade provided by race organizers.

Where there are three tracks, don't feed skiers in middle track.

Wax Testing

Wax testing on other side of tunnel, on Dog Trail – there is a hill for wax testing about 1 km out.

open south trails will be open for wax testing after Open women have completed that section.

Jury will investigate using the stadium for testing during the men's race – this information will be available in the race office

Race Day Procedures

Awards – individual race awards will be presented at the conclusion of each race

Clocks will be started at 8:55 am

General Comments

CCC Race Director: Acknowledgement of race organizing committee, TD and ass't TD, James Cunningham for work on aggregate results.

TD: congratulations on welcome organized event; congratulate coaches for passing on information; please stay stationary when feeding; will be watching for unwarranted lane changes; finish lanes – when heading into finish lanes, they cannot switch lanes unless overtaking another skier; sprints – level of skiing very high, impressed with level of skiing in development round and with juvenile

Chief of Competition: thanks to coaches for bringing all athletes – has been inspiring
